

To create the best possible festival viewing experience:

Amber Tsang Trio

Amber Tsang (she/her) is a young, up-andcoming jazz musician based in Vancouver, B.C. She grew up playing classical piano, then branched out to playing trumpet in jazz ensembles, and eventually, began singing in choirs and as a soloist. Amber aspires to encourage representation and equality with her music for young women of colour in the Vancouver jazz scene.



Angela Verbrugge Trio

Angela Verbrugge received the 2020 JazzTimes Readers' poll award for female jazz vocalist. JazzWeekly describes the former actress as "fun and quirky, hip and a hoot, wispy and romantic; she slithers and oozes, and cleverly swings." Tony Genge also maintains an active career as one of Canada's leading jazz organists and jazz pianists and has performed with many leading Canadian and international jazz artists.



Big City Soul

Ain't no party like a Big City Party! Music is the soul of the city, and Big City Soul brings it every time! This 9-piece band with hot vocals and super-tight musicians brings their high-energy show to this year's festival.



Blues Hoodoo

Blues Hoodoo takes you on an instrumental musical journey of the jazz/funk fusion eras of the 70's & 80's to present day. Along with tasteful selections of cover tunes from the masters, Chick Corea, Jeff Beck, Jaco Pastorius, Herbie Hancock and The Brecker Brothers to name a few, the band also features original material that showcases their tightness, musical expressions and harmonic adventure. A lower mainland festival favorite, cool grooves, a fun atmosphere, with consistent sold out venues wherever they perform.



Brandon Isaak & His Saints of Swing

Brandon Isaak & his Saints Of Swing are one of the most accomplished blues bands in the Vancouver area. The group is made up of all star musicians who are all veterans on the music scene. The band is high energy blues with elements of swing, funk and gospel with exceptional guitar, piano, upright bass, drums and vocals. The Saints Of Swing bring a high level of professionalism, originality and talent to the Canadian blues scene.



Conga Cartel

From the roots of Afro Cuban music to Clavé infused jazz this Vancouver based group, led by percussionist extraordinary Jack Duncan, illuminates and illustrates the historical and evolving intersection of jazz and traditional Afro Latin music.





Daniel Hersog Jazz Orchestra with Special Guests David Restivo and Steve Kaldestad

The Daniel Hersog Jazz Orchestra has performed throughout North America featuring a host of the world's leading improvisors. This past summer Daniel led his band in Toronto, Montreal, Boston and New York. This tour featured renowned soloists Frank Carlberg and Noah Preminger. David Restivo and Steve Kaldestad are featured instead of Frank Carlsberg and Noah Preminger due to travel restrictions. Featuring a who's who of Vancouver's top musicians, the DHJO deftly navigates Daniel's modern and exciting compositions. With brilliant ensemble playing, fiery improvisation, and a swinging sensibility, this band is not to be missed.



David Restivo Trio

David Restivo is one of Canada's most respected and influential jazz artists. He is a three-time winner of the National Jazz Awards' Pianist of the Year Award, and is listed in the current edition of Canadian Who's Who. Born in Lansing, Michigan, molded by the mountains and coasts of New England, and based primarily in Toronto since 1982, he has been a soughtafter and influential figure in Canada's jazz community since the late 1980s.



Dawn Pemberton

Vancouver soul dynamo Dawn Pemberton has a deep musical foundation rooted in tradition. Dawn spent her formative years surrounded by a family of multi-instrumentalists and developed a true love of music as a young girl. In addition to regularly collaborating on the projects of her peers and having an educated background in jazz voice and piano, Dawn is a talented and passionate songwriter in her own right. A staple of the West Coast music scene, Dawn can be found tearing it up as a vocalist, arranger, and go-to for live performances and studio sessions.



Dee Daniels

Dee Daniels is a crowd pleaser and a musician's musician. Whether accompanying herself at the piano, fronting a trio, big band or symphony, she is a unique talent who transcends musical borders when she brings her jazz styling, infused with gospel and blues flavouring, to the stage. Many organizations and institutions in and out of the music industry have recognized Dee with awards for her contributions in music, education, and community service.



Jim Byrnes Band with special guest Candus Churchill

St. Louis bred, Byrnes moved to Vancouver, BC in the mid-70s after years of drifting, working odd jobs and playing music. He's been a mainstay on both the music and screen scenes ever since. His fame as an actor equals his legendary music status. From his numerous TV and movie roles, highlights include the Wiseguy and Highlander series, and his national variety show, The Jim Byrnes Show.





Kenny "Blues Boss" Wayne Trio

Wayne was born in Spokane, Washington and has been performing for over 50 years. Over the years he has shared the stage with a great many of the world's most influential blues pioneers, including Jimmy Reed, Pinetop Perkins, Johnnie Johnson, Big Joe Duskin, Joe Louis Walker and Floyd Dixon, and as a guest performer with well-known rock and soul artists that have included Ike Turner, Sly and the Family Stone, Delaney and Bonnie and members of Santana and the Doobie Brothers. As a touring performer, he has played to knowledgeable and appreciative blues audiences on four continents and has been profiled by music journalists in Europe and North America.



Kyprios

A triple threat. Spoken word poetry, music and acting are all embedded in the DNA of kyprios. After winning a slam in NYC's sacred Nuyorican Poetry Cafe, kyp started his own poetry night in Vancouver and began to generate a buzz around his lyricism. Shortly thereafter, the music industry came calling. Pledging to push boundaries of sampled hip hop by utilizing live musicians, kyprios is identified by a fleshed out, full bodied musical style.



Mike Rud Trio

Mike Rud is a Juno award-winning jazz guitarist and songwriter. He is also a music instructor at Selkirk College in Nelson, BC. As an instrumentalist, Mike has played along side some of the greatest musicians of the era like Peter Bernstine, Kenny Wheeler, Herb Ellis and Joey DeFrancesco. As a songwriter and arranger, Mike won the 2014 uni award for his album "Notes on Montreal, a critically acclaimed musical portrait of the city.



Mike Van Eyes

The notorious Mike Van Eyes is a Vancouver legend. A master of boogie woogie rockin' rhythm n' soul with a healthy splash of mischief. Over the past four decades Mr. Van Eyes has lent his talents to a broad range of artists from local heroes Herald Nix and Colin James, GI Blues and The Yodells — to wild rockers like The Trespassers and Copyright. Along the way he's played with everyone from PeeWee Clayton to Hubert Sumlin with shows across North America and Europe. Most recently Mike has recorded an ambitious debut solo album at Afterlife Studios (formerly Mushroom). Two LP's chock full of tunes with a smoking 18 piece band!



Noxious Obs

Purveyors of revelry and sonic pleasure since 2018: a mobile party band for all occasions and predicaments, serving the lower mainland and its environs. While still a relatively newish ensemble, this young group has already released two E.P.s (available at bandcamp.com). Made up of current and former students of New Westminster Secondary School, and directed by Mr. Steve Clements, this New-Orleans-meets Klezmer-Balkan Brass band is a mobile unit that can entertain at the drop of a hat. Expect the unexpected!



RazzMaJazz Brigade

The RazzMaJazz Brigade is a popular and entertaining band that performs traditional jazz, creole, New Orleans style jazz and dixieland. Comprised of top professional jazz musicians, the six-piece New Orleans style band features multiple horns and a swinging rhythm section. This highly entertaining and energetic band will lead the Mardi Gras parade from the Fort Langley Village Farmer's Market to the historical Fort Langley community hall to kick off the in-person outdoor festival.





Red Haven

Drawing inspiration from jazz and soul but redesigning it with Indie-Pop songwriting and a heavy backbeat, Red Haven have been touring their raucous, spirited brand of music for the past five years. Featuring the work of songwriters Jen Charters, Nathan Turner, and Brendan Steele, Red Haven tells a story that is both entertaining and incisive.



Steelin' Crazy Rhythm

Steelin' Crazy Rhythm create an exciting blend of instrumental and vocal western swing and jazz routed in the sounds of the early western swing bands of the 1940s. Made up of some of Western Canada's finest swing, country and jazz artists, the band will get you skipping. It features the pedal steel guitar playing of Tom Hammel, band leader, who recorded the group's first album in 2020 and legendary guitarist Paul Pigat.



Stomi:x Shweli (Warrior Spirit)

It is a teaching moment on each side. It is a learning moment. Each person in Stomi:<u>x</u> Shweli brings their own story and their own talents as artists. This is a time of shared hopes and visions coming to life. The value that each artist can bring to this performance is going to be one of a kind. This Indigenous-Jazz fusion project will showcase the rich culture of Kwantlen First Nations and provide an opportunity to share their music, their teachings and stories with people from all over the world in a new and innovative way.



Triology

Formed in 2008, Triology is a jazz trio featuring three of Canada's most sought-after jazz musicians. This group was fashioned after the great early jazz trios of Nat King Cole and Oscar Peterson and features wonderful arrangements of classic standards, as well as original tunes by the trio members.



Vince Mai Quintet

As trumpeter, Vince has appeared on hundreds of recordings for TV, feature films. commercials, and albums. Versatility is one of his major assets and artists he's shared the stage or studio with include - Sarah McLughlin, Michael Buble, Powder Blues Band, Natalie Cole, Eddie Daniels and many others.



William Chernoff Quartet

William is a prolific jazz composer and bassist under 30 years old. He has earned Canadian airplay on CBC's Saturday Night Jazz, CKUA's A Time For Jazz, and Jazz Boulevard. In 2020, he received a FACTOR Artist Development grant and released his first album, Aim to Stay.



XLThe Band

XL The Band is a Western Canadian Music Award nominated hip-hop/jazz/ alternative fusion band with a deep and rich history in the music industry. XL is a new artistic project launched by some of Canada's leading musicians and the body of work they've created runs the gamut of musical genres.
