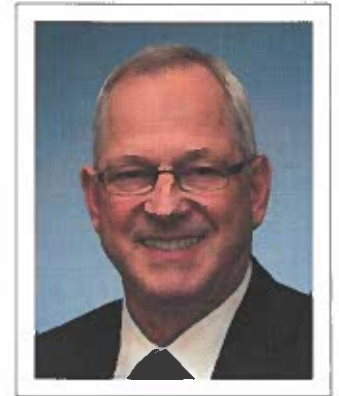

It is my pleasure to welcome you to the Odlum Brown Fort Langley Jazz & Arts Festival 2021!


